### How to Read Grade Symbols

- The Grades, Duration, and Year Type columns in Toyo's transcript are indicated in alphabetical symbols.
- Exchange students can see this transcript to get a rough idea of how your final grade when credits are transferred to the home university.
- All courses last 15 weeks per semester, and the length of each class is 1.5 hour (or 90 minutes). Usually, Toyo University gives a regular Toyo student 2 credits for each lecture or seminar course per semester. For a foreign language course (except Japanese language courses), laboratory work course and physical education course, the student is given 1 credit.
- Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) requires studying of 45 hours to give one credit. At Toyo University, in principle, one credit is given for 15 hours of classes plus 30 hours of self-learning in the case of lectures and seminar courses. Incidentally, 45 minutes of course hour is regarded as one credit hour. Incidentally, depending on the characteristics of the classes, the hours of classes are increased or decreased.
